Rating News 2017 Period 3

Ben Hague has taken top place from Anthony Ker on the standard ratings list followed by Russell Dive, Alexei Kulashko and Bruce Watson. Alphaeus Ang moves into the top ten for the first time, up seven places to 8th. Graeme Spain, last seen in 2009, is the highest new entry in 18th after his comeback in the Waikato Open. The biggest mover is Michael Nyberg, up thirteen places to 32nd.

Puchen Wang remains at the top of the rapid ratings list. Ben Hague and Russell Dive trade places, Anthony Ker is 4th ahead of Scott Wastney and Alexei Kulashko who also trade places. Daniel Runcan is the biggest climber, up seven places to 35th. Vyanla Punslan is the highest new entry in 44th.

Layla Timergazi heads the women's standard ratings ahead of Sherry Li and Helen Milligan who swap places. Sue Maroroa is at the top of the rapid ratings, followed by Vyanla Punslan who moves up two places and Layla Timergazi.

There are no changes in top three on all senior and veteran rating lists.

Alphaeus Ang climbs two places to the top of the junior standard ratings. Hans Gao holds onto 2nd place with Daniel Gong dropping to 3rd. Alphaeus Ang moved up one place but that wasn't enough to displace Hans Gao at the top of the junior rapid ratings. Daniel Gong has a brace of 3rd places.

Standard Rated Tournaments

In **period 1**, the **open** tournaments are: New Zealand Open incorporating the 124th New Zealand Championship, New Zealand Junior Open, Oceania Zonals and Auckland Anniversary. The **club** tournaments are: Howick-Pakuranga Booth Shield, Wellington Championships (A –D) and Otago's Richard Sutton Trophy.

In **period 2,** the **open** tournaments are: Auckland Anzac and May, Trusts Open (A, B, C, Junior) and Wellington Open. The **club** tournaments are: Auckland Summer (A, B1, B2, C, D) and Autumn (A, B), Howick-Pakuranga Parkinson and Fairhurst, Wellington Summer and Autumn (A – H), Canterbury Colthart and Chas L Hart, and Otago Championships (A1, B1, C1).

In **period 3,** the **open** tournaments are: NZ Junior, NZ Senior, Asian Seniors and Veterans, North Island, North Shore Open (A, B, C), George Trundle Masters, Qualifiers and Reserves, Merv Morrison Memorial, Waikato Open (A, B) and South Island. The **club** tournaments are: Auckland Championships (A - C) and Winter Cup (A - C), North Shore Championships (A - C), Howick-Pakuranga Championship, Wellington Julian Mazur Memorial, Upper Hutt Championships (A - C), Canterbury Championships (A, B) and Eric Browne Shield, Otago Championships (A2 - C2) and Cleland.

Rapid Rated Tournaments

In **period 1**, the **open** tournaments are: New Zealand Championship, Auckland Junior (November and December 2016, January and February 2017), Papatoetoe Open (A - D, Junior), Bay of Plenty (A, B, Junior) and Hawkes Bay (A, B). The **club** tournaments are: Mount Maunganui Championship and Canterbury's Arie Nijman Trophy.

In **period 2,** the **open** tournaments are: Latvian (A – D), Auckland Junior (March, April, May, June), Tairawhiti Open and Upper Hutt (A, B, C). The **club** tournaments are: North Shore Championship (1, 2), Wellington Championship, Otago Allan Chang and Swiss.

In **period 3**, the **open** tournaments are: NZ Junior, North Island, Auckland Junior (August, September and October), South Island and Feilding. The **club** tournaments are: Howick-Pakuranga Sutton Memorial. President's and Allegro, and Otago Championship (1, 2).

Change

Previously, an established player inactive for ten years was deleted from the ratings system. If the player returned to active rated play after ten years then they would start as an unrated player. However, this does not make a lot of sense. If a player had returned to rated play after 9.5 years his rating would still be intact, yet after 10.5 years, his rating is zeroed. It is better to use a player's rating even if it is old. With so much chess available on the internet, it is quite likely that such players are still active anyway. This change has been retroactively applied.
