INFORMATION ABOUT MEASLES FOR CHESS PLAYERS AND PARENTS

Chess players and parents who are considering playing in a chess event while the current **MEASLES** outbreak is ongoing should be aware of the following:

You are NOT IMMUNE and are at risk of getting measles if:

- You were born AFTER 1 January 1969 and have NOT had at least one dose of MMR vaccine after your first birthday, or haven't had measles
- You are "immunocompromised" where a medical condition or medication has weakened your immune system.

If you are NOT IMMUNE to measles then you should consider whether you wish to play in or attend a chess event where you may be exposed to the disease.
